RaziaG: I am from New York city the city that never sleeps

RubyGst2: I'm from California and teaching Special Education in a technology magnet school

DianneA: Ruby we can talk about integrating technology if that is of particular interest to you

DianneA: thanks every one ...

RaziaG: no problem

RubyGst2: Yes

DianneA: Ruby would you like to share a bit more to help us focus a discussion on

integrating technology ...

DianneA: like why you would like to raise that ...

DianneA: do you have a practice situation and story that can help us focus?

RubyGst2: I am familiar with some web sites with games...

DianneA listens

RubyGst2: but would be interesting with something that had progress monitoring

DianneA: Ruby, can you explain to me a bit more about what you mean by 'a technology

magnet school'?

RubyGst2: classes are geared with an emphasis in math and sciences

applications that are game based and with progress monitoring?

DianneA: Hello Stephanie

StephanieO: hi

RubyGst2: Oh yes that would be amazing

DianneA: welcome to Teaching Teachers

RaziaG: Hi Stephanie

StephanieO: may I join this discussion

StephanieO: I am new

RaziaG: I am not alone anymore

DianneA: Of course Stephanie ...

RaziaG: I mean as being new

StephanieO: how do I join

DianneA: Rub has just set us a task ...

DianneA: you are joining already by chatting

StephanieO: ok

StephanieO: I see

StephanieO: thanks

DianneA: Ruby has asked if any of us know of ...

DianneA: websites, for math and sciences applications that are game based and with progress monitoring?

DianneA: and would be suitable for special education students

DianneA: before we follow up Bj's suggestion ...

StephanieO: yes

StephanieO: so I have limited resources

DianneA: thanks Stephanie

DianneA: then what that means for us now is that we need to learn a bit more about using

Tapped In ...

DianneA: to take up Bj's suggestion

RaziaG: yes

DianneA: So

DianneA: since Stephanie and Razia are and feel new and Ruby is a guest ...

DianneA: we have to take the next couple of steps in the same way we usually do Tips

and Tricks

DianneA: I work on learning by doing ...

StephanieO: great idea

DianneA: and Tapped In is a resource for teacher professional development ...

RaziaG: ok

DianneA: it is made up of sessions like this when teachers come to find out things from

other teachers

DianneA: and where we utilise the practice knowledge of other teachers in sharing ...

DianneA: BJ has mentioned that there are some games resources for math and science in

another place here at Tapped In

DianneA: so we have to learn to move from here to there ...

DianneA: and we have some tricks for that ...

DianneA: first of all, BJ would you like to move to the Playing and learning room, please

DianneA: while BJ does that do you all see the HERE and ONLINE tab to the left of this

chat space?

DianneA: click on the ONLINE tab and tell me what you notice there

RubyGst2: thanks forgive me I need to exit the room, something has just come up. I am very sorry, thank you for all your time and help!

StephanieO: yes I see it

RubyGst2 left the room (signed off).

DianneA: OK Ruby, thank you and bye for now

RaziaG: me too

DianneA: click on the ONLINE tab and tell me what you notice there

RaziaG: I see names and the group information

StephanieO: wow where are all those people

DianneA: good Razia

DianneA nods to Stephanie

DianneA: It looks like GarySt's office is the place to be ...

BJB2 left the room.

Room: Playground

BJB2 joined the room.

RaziaG joined the room.

BJB2: good job, Razia

RaziaG: Thanks

StephanieO joined the room.

DianneA joined the room.

DianneA: well done

DianneA: OK BJ ... here we are ...

DianneA: Razia and Stephanie ...

DianneA: do you notice that in this room are some indications of games resources ...

StephanieO: yes

StephanieO: here I am

RaziaG: yes

DianneA: if you scroll down in the main window above this chat space

DianneA: you will see more of the text ...

DianneA: and a box of Featured Items ...

DianneA: and a folder of links of Math and Science Games and Puzzles

DianneA: if you click on that folder link ...

RaziaG: I see featured passageways

StephanieO: I see it

DianneA: you have gone down a bit too far Razia

DianneA nods to Stephanie

DianneA: wait while we catch up Stephanie

RaziaG: is it called playing to learn?

DianneA: Razia this room and group is called Playing to Learn

RaziaG: ok

StephanieO: I see

StephanieO: that on top

DianneA: now just check for me both of you that you have the welcome window open ...

DianneA: you can open the welcome window by clicking on the welcome link in the left

hand menu

RaziaG: yes

DianneA: and there are two text boxes ... 'Welcome to Playing to Learn' and 'African Mathematical Games' ...

StephanieO: not yet waiting

DianneA: then as you scroll down slowly

StephanieO: ok I see it

RaziaG: yes

StephanieO: so each group has a different welcome

DianneA: you will se a box labeled Featured Items

DianneA: yes Stephanie

RaziaG: yes

DianneA: and under the featured Items you will see a folder called Math and Science Games

DianneA: click on that link

DianneA: notice the whole series of links to webpages ...

DianneA: these are webpages that other teachers have recommended

DianneA: if you click on any one of those links your computer will open that webpage in another window

DianneA: and so we could, if you wished ...

RaziaG: I see

DianneA: conduct a conversation here about that web resource

StephanieO: ok

StephanieO: is this where all the people from "online" were at

DianneA: are you with me on that way of sharing web resources here at Tapped In and having related professional conversations about those resources ..

RaziaG: I could use these games to plan a lesson plan for my students

DianneA: not quite Stephanie ...

DianneA: what I suspect is happening for most of the people "online" ...

DianneA: especially the one's in GarySt's office ...

DianneA: is that they have arranged to meet with Gary St to have a particular chat session about a particular subject

DianneA: let me show you another tip ...

BJB2 . o O (Gary teaches a Pepperdine grad class)

DianneA: at the very top of your main window is a Tapped In tab, please click on that

DianneA: thanks BJB

RaziaG: should I too

DianneA: a campus map should open up for you

StephanieO: ok

StephanieO: I see it

DianneA: and on that campus map is a subtab for the Tapped In Calendar ...

DianneA: please click on the Calendar subtab

DianneA: and tell me when you have the calendar open

RaziaG: I do

DianneA: Stephanie, do you have the calendar open?

DianneA: that calendar shows what sessions are scheduled for when, and what their topics are ...

DianneA: so if you have a particular interest in joining a session you can know when it is on ...

DianneA: and if you then click on the active link to a session that interests you, you will see who is conducting it ... (leader) and where it is held (event room) ...

BJB2 . o O (you both have your calendars set to your time zone so you see the events in your time)

RaziaG: yes

StephanieO: yes

DianneA: OK let's check out next week's program for Learning from Lyrics ...

DianneA: click on that active link

JeffC joined the room.

DianneA: who is the presenter/ leader for that session?

RaziaG: Johnathan Chase

StephanieO: what date?

DianneA: Jeff we are just checking using the calendar ...

DianneA: thanks Razia

DianneA: and where is the session being held (event room)?

StephanieO: I see it

StephanieO: the event information

DianneA nods to Stephanie

RaziaG: 10/20 at 9pm

DianneA: now another tip ...

DianneA: see the open door icon ...

DianneA: besides the Event Room ...

RaziaG: yes

DianneA: that is where the session will be held ...

DianneA: and to go there ...

DianneA: all you need to do is click on the open door ...

StephanieO left the room.

DianneA: so let's try that and see what that room looks like

BJB2 left the room.

BJB2 joined the room.

DianneA: Ok Stephanie ...

DianneA: notice the changes in the room

BJB2: Razia, do you see the door icon to the learning from lyrics room?
